Purchase video camera	January 2007	U.S.A.	Upon receipt of funds from UNESCO, order video camera. Time should be allotted to facilitate shipment of this equipment before the actual implementation of the project.
Training of youth to use the equipment	February 2007 (depending on arrival date of shipment)	Kingstown or Bequia	Youth selected for training will travel to the Agency for Public Information, Kingstown, St. Vincent, or alternatively, have someone from API come down to Bequia on weekends.
Videotaping of cheer-giving activities	February 2007 onwards	Different villages across the island of Bequia	Plan, organize and conduct at least ten (10) cheer-giving visits by the youth to elderly persons in their homes in Bequia and videotape the elderly as they tell their stories.

Videotaping of drying of whale	Between January and April which is the whaling season (depending on whether a whale is caught in 2007)	Any of the villages on the island.	The whaling season runs annually between Jan. and April and although the hunt takes place each year, not every year sees the capture of one of them. Therefore, filming of this tradition will depend on the availability of meat.
Videotaping of drying of fish	No set date.	Paget Farm	We would like to videotape the arrival of the fishing boats with fresh fish, and interview the fishermen, as well as videotape the salting and drying of the fish.
Corn grinding in traditional mill. Farine production.	August?	Paget Farm	Depending on the rainy season and when the crops mature. Weather patterns have been changing and planting and harvesting are unpredictable. Videotaping will hinge on harvesting of crop.
Videotaping of usage of traditional herbal medicine	Between June and September		Filming of actual plants and explanations of their uses.
Editing of production	September/October	API Kingstown	Seek assistance with editing from Agency for Public Information.
Airing of production	Week of October 27/07	Radio, television, newspapers	As part of celebrations of 28 th anniversary of Independence, we will air interviews with the elderly on Bequia Community Radio, and send

			articles to the local newspapers, as well as television footage for news and API programming.
Submission of report and other materials produced under the contract to UNESCO.
