

Tetsuya Hasegawa

Short Biography

Tetsuya Hasegawa was born in Gifu, Japan in 1946, and was awarded a M.F.A. degree by Tokyo University of the Arts in 1972. From 1978, an associate professor and from 1991 a professor at Wakayama University, taught the theory and history of art education, and researched the philosophy and history. From 1986 to 1987 he was a visiting researcher at Hamburg University researching the history of the philosophy of art education and aesthetic education. Awarded doctorate by Tokyo University of the Arts in 2003, for the dissertation "*Study on the History of Muse-Education Theories in Modern Germany*", which was published separately in 2005. In 2009, a book "*Bauhaus and Its Contribution to the Reformation of German Art Colleges after 1945*" was published in collaboration with Professor Mikio Suzuki of Kobe University.
