Initial results: 2009 IAU Global Survey on Internationalization of Higher Education

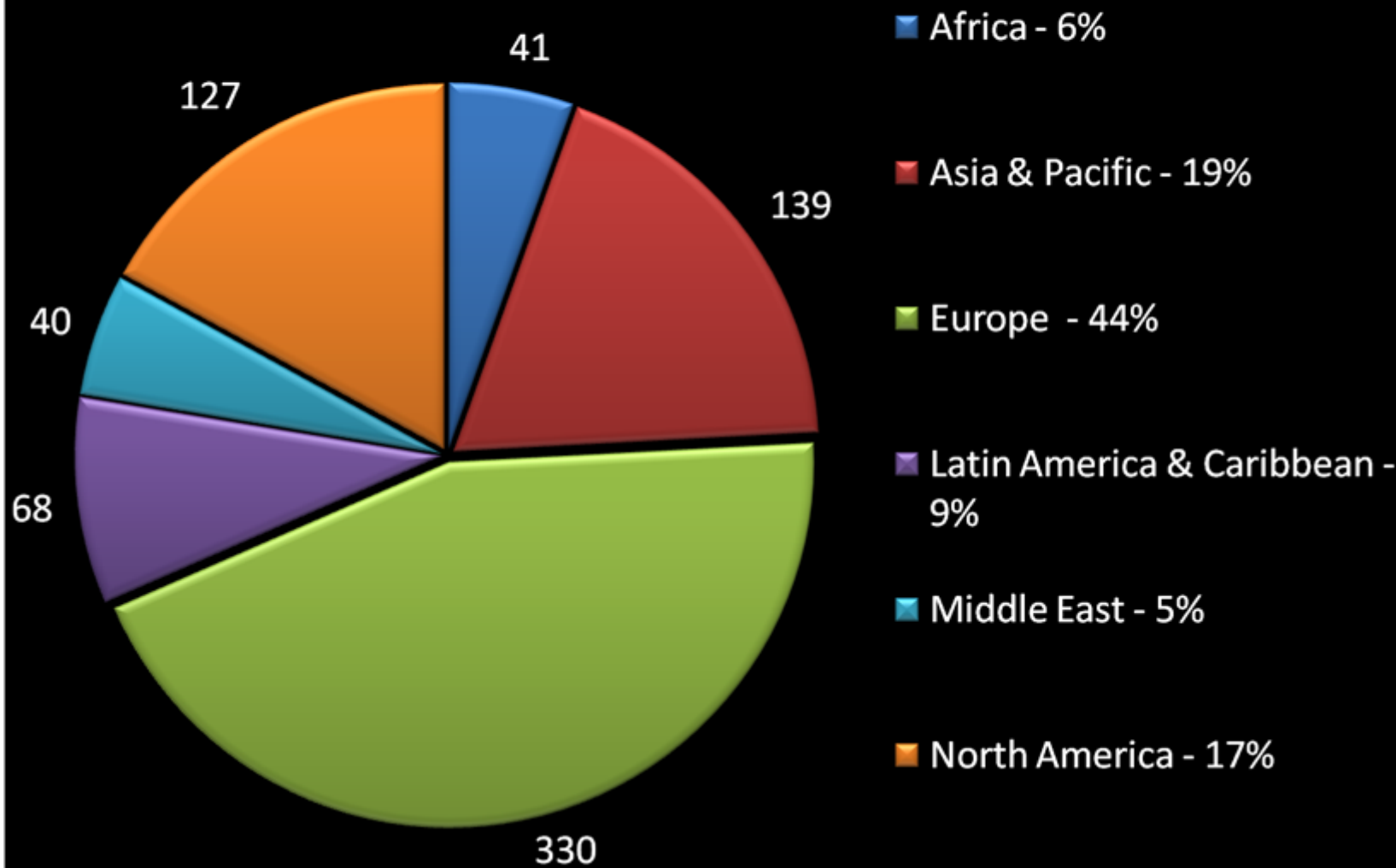
Having completed data collection for the 3rd IAU Global Survey in late June, 2009, IAU is pleased to share with a few aggregate level key results, providing a first glimpse at the most comprehensive survey on internationalization of higher education yet conducted. Indeed, responses in this edition of the survey were received from higher education institutions in 115 countries around the world.

Further analysis of all data collected from higher education institutions and university associations is currently underway, and the final report will be available in early 2010.

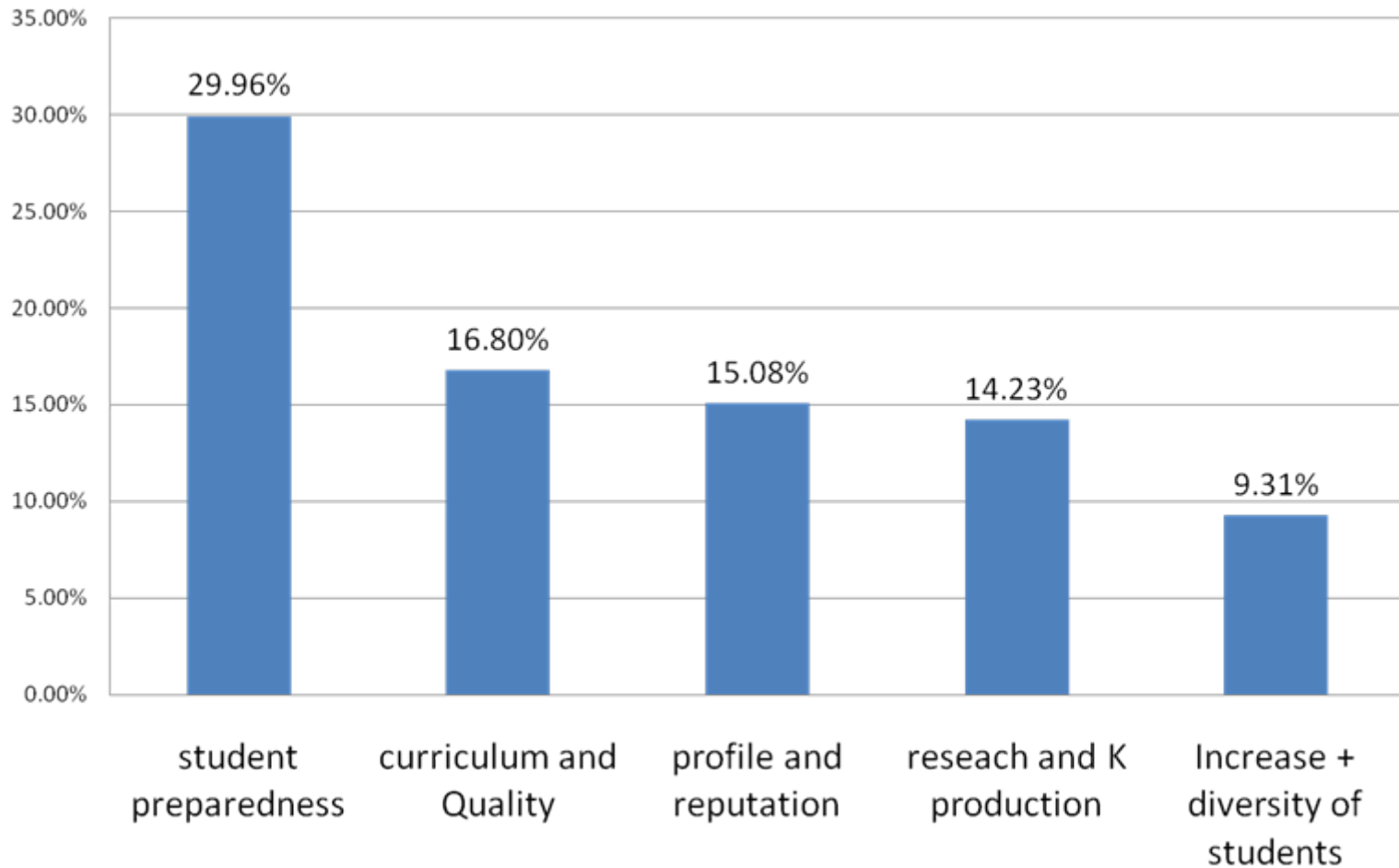

N = 745



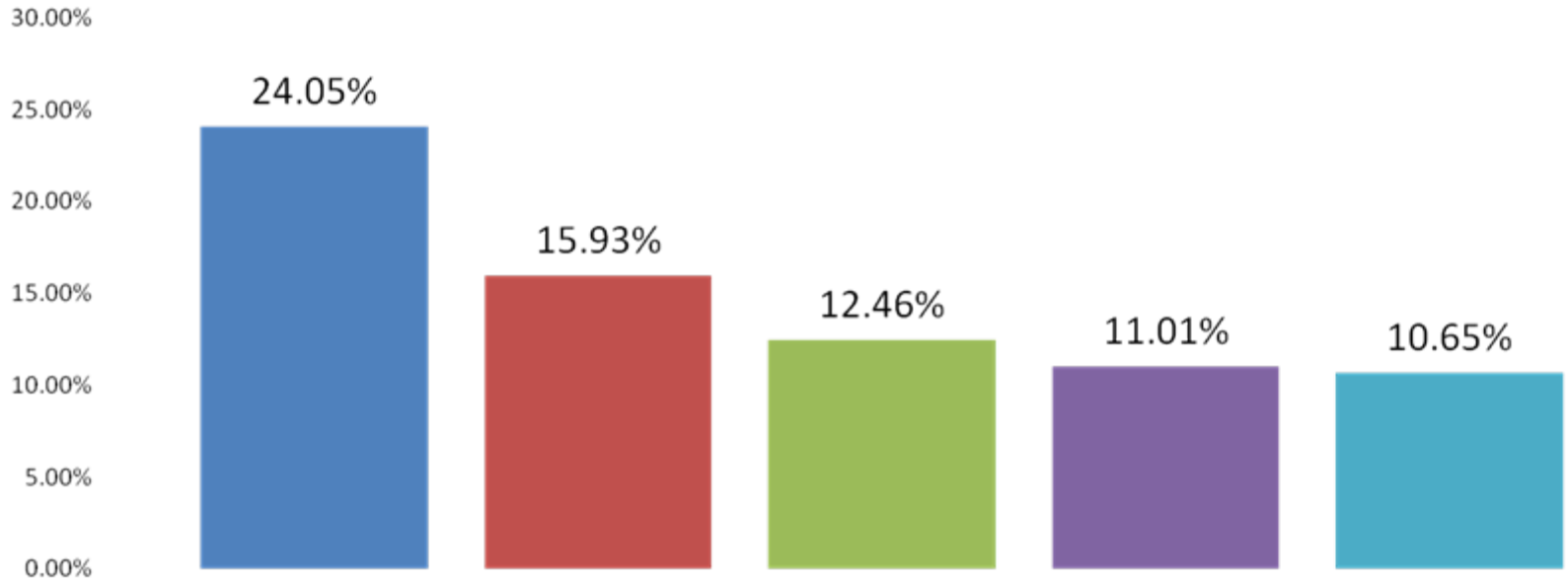
Top Rationales for Internationalization
