The UNESCO Regional Office for Culture for Latin America and the Caribbean, based in Havana, Cuba, is seeking qualified interns interested in enhancing their skills and opportunities in the international assistance and development fields of culture, education, natural sciences, social and human sciences and communications and information.

Interns will work directly with the Director of the Office at the regional and sub-regional level, gaining experience through assistance in programme implementation, desk reviews, writing and editing documents, monitoring and reporting, resource mobilization, project proposal development, and UN System support and coordination.

Candidates should have a Bachelor's Degree in an area of study relevant to UNESCO's mandate. Preference will be given to those who have completed or are currently studying at the master's level.

Candidates should also have native English and an excellent command, both written and spoken, of Spanish and should be able to work well in a team, adapt to an international working environment and possess strong interpersonal and communication skills.

As UNESCO does not remunerate interns, candidates are expected to finance all travel and living expenses themselves or through a sponsor. Interns will receive a Certificate of Completion following their tenure at the office.

The duration of the internship is for a minimum of 6 months.
