


The objects are the following (pictures below):

1. Pottery vase (kyathion) with one vertical handle, decorated in reddish-brown horizontal zigzag line (Mycenean period).
2. Pottery jug (prochous) with one vertical, cylindrical handle, decorated with Mycenaean flowers (Mycenean period).
3. Pottery jug (prochous), conical, with flat base and one vertical handle, decorated in black.
4. Pottery vase (Corinthian pyxis) with two vertical, cylindrical handles, shoulder decorated in black with schematic leaves.
5. Pottery vase (black-figured lekythos), with two satyrs dancing and two figures seated. Tongues and rays on the shoulder.
6. Pottery vase (black-figured lekythos), with a charioteer mounting a quadriga, a man before the quadriga and two women behind it. Dotted zigzag band above the scene, double line of rays on the shoulder.
7. White Ground lekythos decorated in black with a band of trailing ivy with berries, flanked by meander and lattice panels.
8. Lekythos, with black glazed body, with meander band above and below it. Two rows of rays on the shoulder.
9. Piece (neck) of a black glazed vase.
10. Black glazed vase (kantharos cup of Boeotic type).
11. Black glazed cup kylix. Four stamped palmettes on the bottom, inside the vase.
12. Miniature basin (lekanis), made from red clay, with one horizontal handle.
13. Terracotta lamp, with short, rectangular hole and two palmettes on its periphery.
14. Terracotta bust of a woman with wavy hair wearing a diadem and a veil. Two small holes for suspension.
15. Terracotta figurine of a standing woman wearing a long chiton and an himation. Made of red clay.
16. Vase (squat lekythos) with black net pattern and white dots.
