Contributions of the Joint Programme to the implementation of UNESCO's Conventions on culture



2005 UNESCO Convention on the Protection and Promotion of the Diversity of Cultural Expressions

Joint Programme actions:

- **Creativity and production of cultural expressions** have been nurtured, particularly in the crafts, music and publishing sub-sectors of the creative industries:
 - Technical support for craftsmen to improve their designs;
 - 18 Cultural Factories established to train and support cultural entrepreneurs;
 - 11 cultural factories created to improve access to remote or costly cultural goods/services such as audiovisual and music production technologies;
 - Creation of a Music Cluster and of a Publishing Cluster within the government;
 - 60 national stakeholders trained in cultural enterprises management;
 - 4 capacity building workshops organized in 3 penitentiary centres in the areas of visual arts and crafts, performance and celebration, books and press;
 - Business incubator set up for cultural enterprises.

Joint Programme products:

- **Creativity and production of cultural expressions** have been nurtured through the publication of a book on cultural content and communication methods;
- Products aiming to **integrate culture into sustainable development policies and programmes** at the national level:
 - Strategic plan to strengthen the competitiveness of the Music Cluster;
 - Strategic plan to strengthen the competitiveness of the Publishing Cluster.
