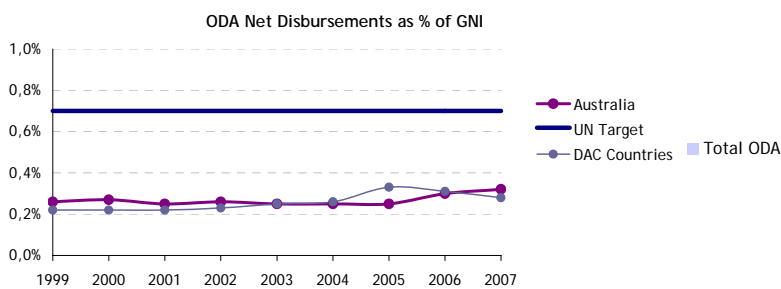

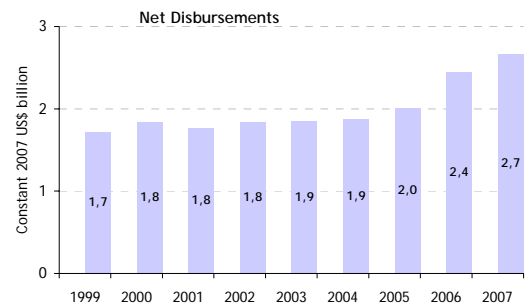

### Total ODA



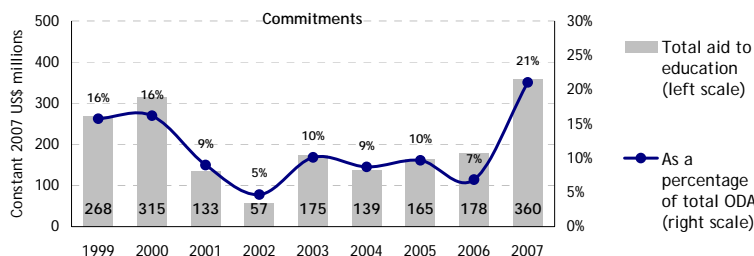
ODA as percentage of GNI increased since 1999 and remained below the 0.7% target.

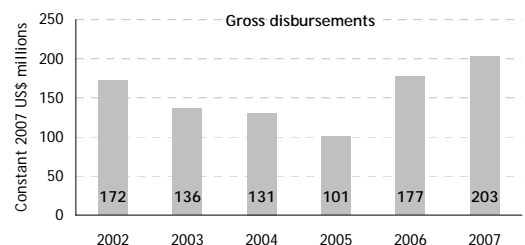

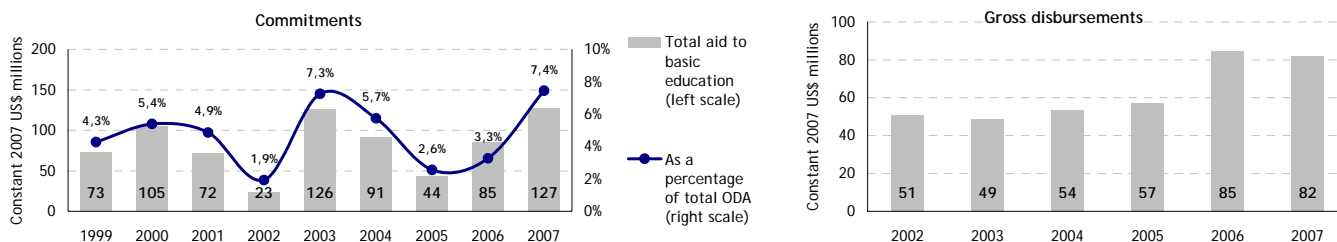

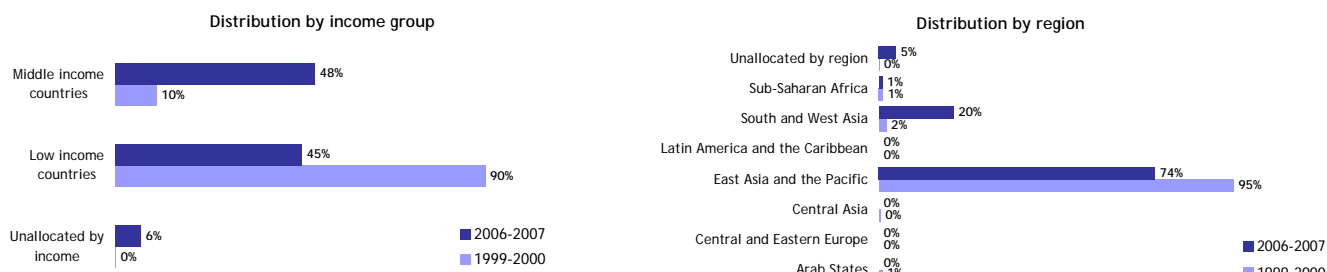

### Total ODA



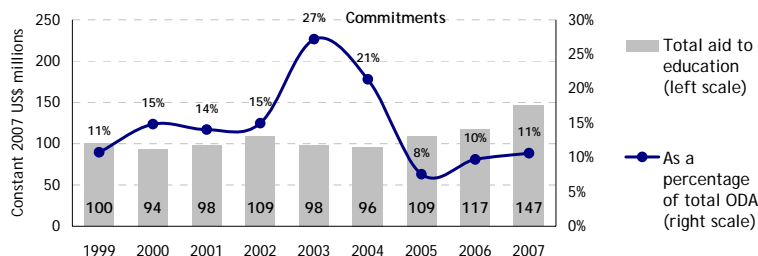

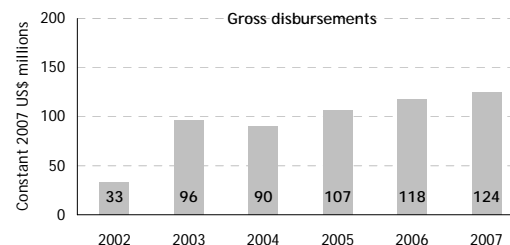

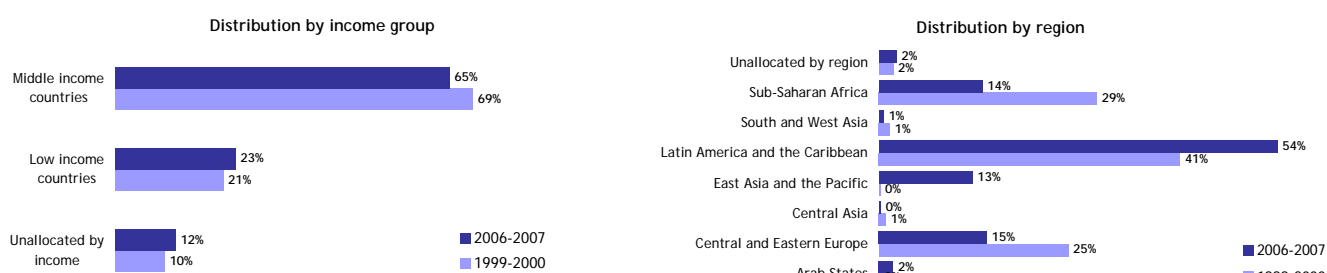

### Total ODA



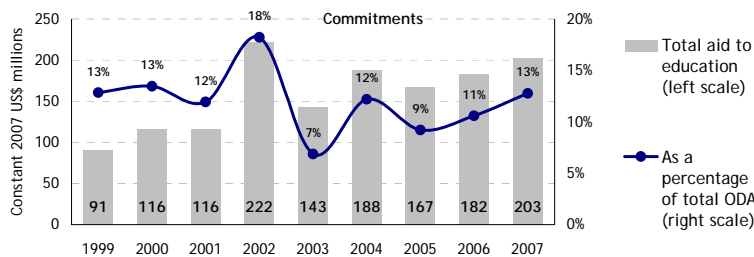

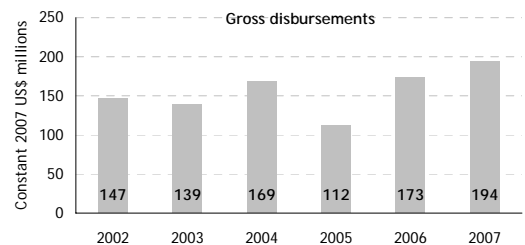

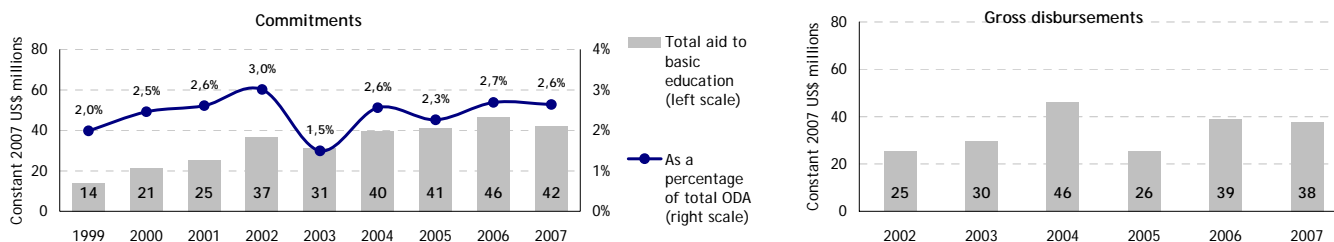

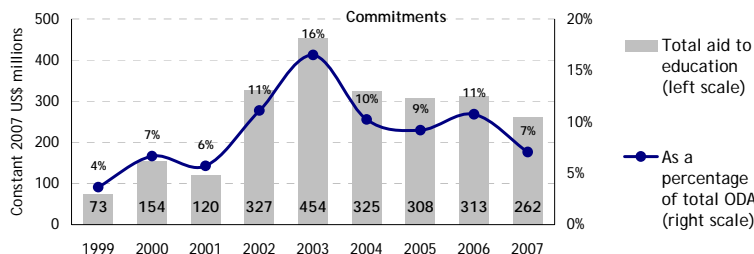

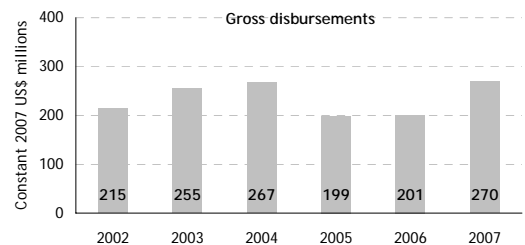

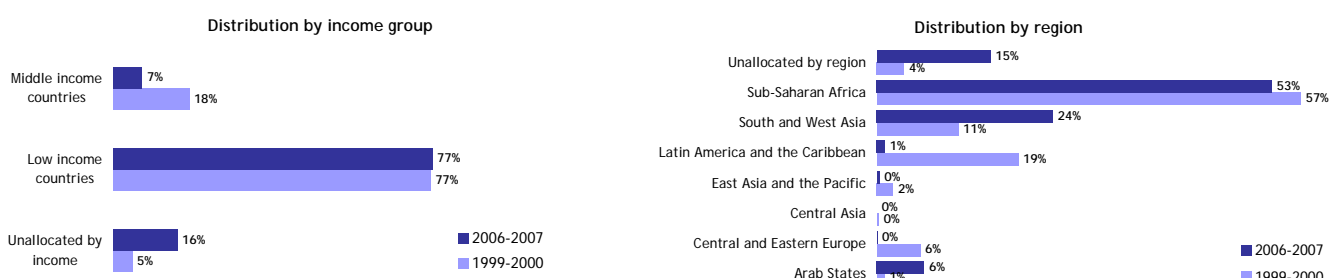

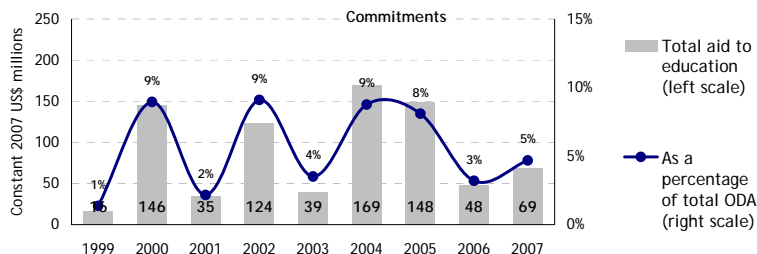

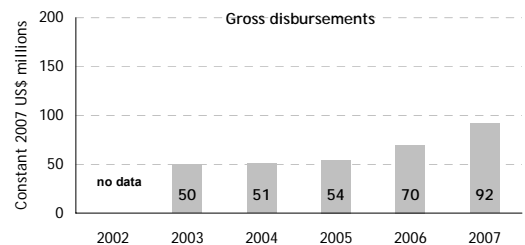

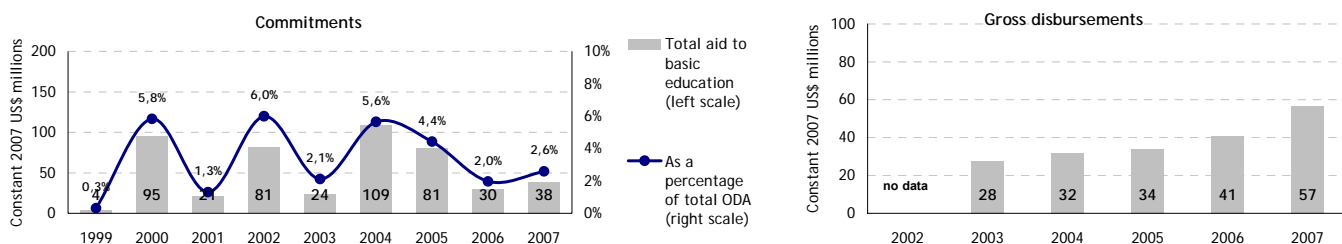

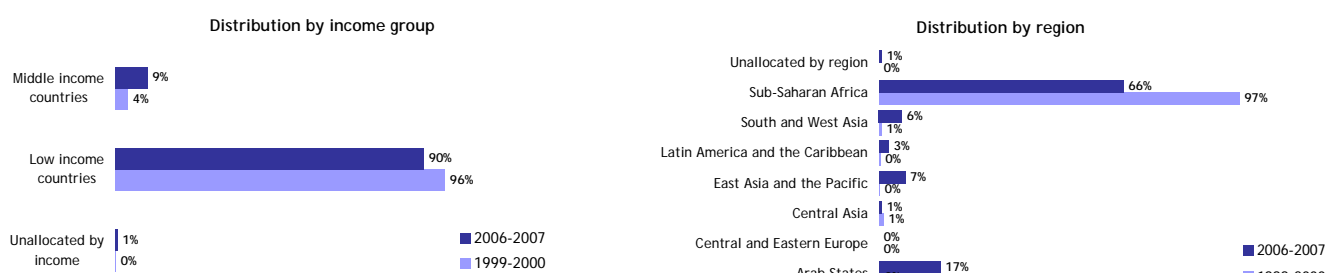

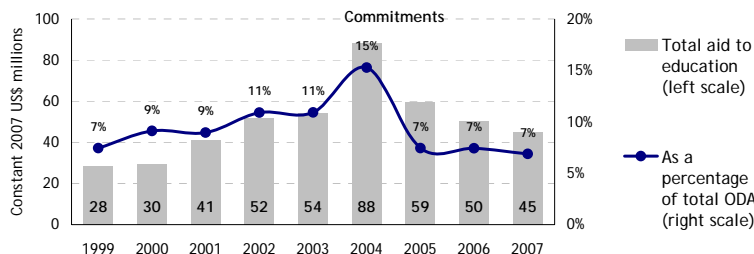

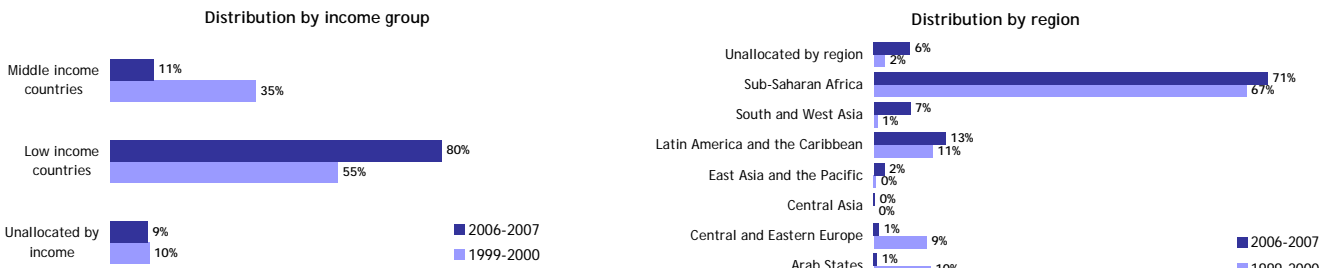

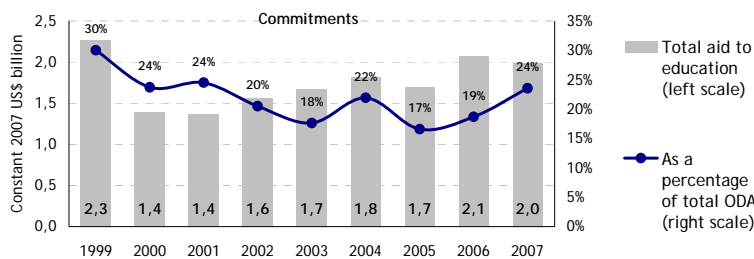

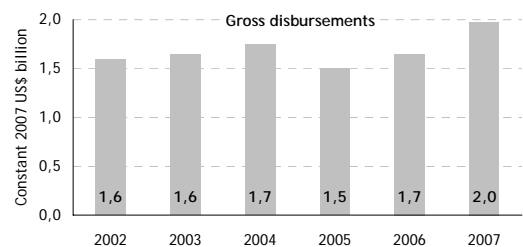

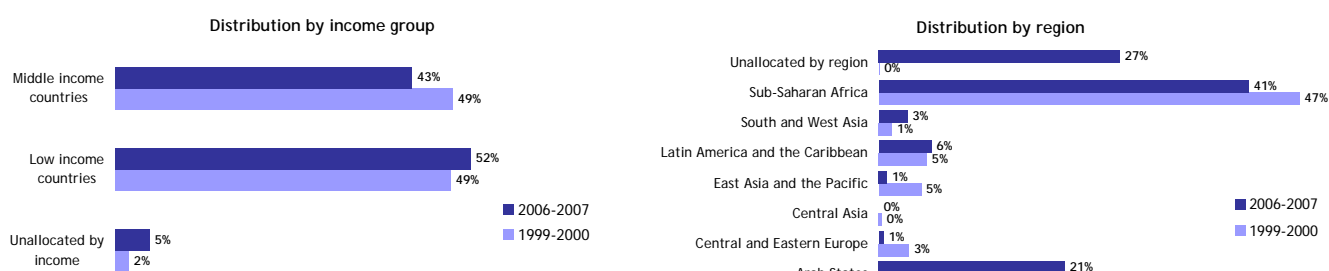

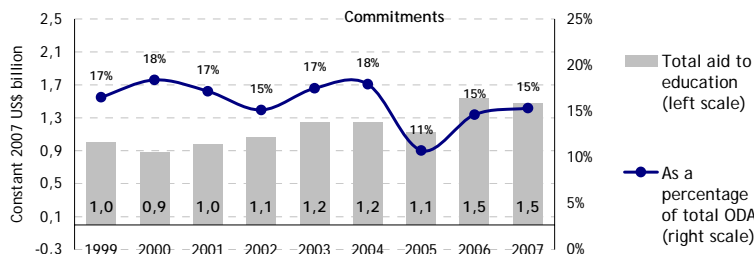

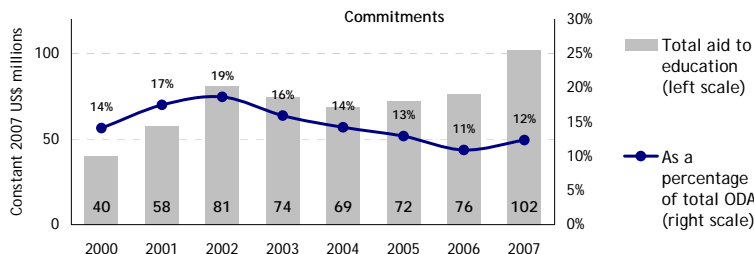

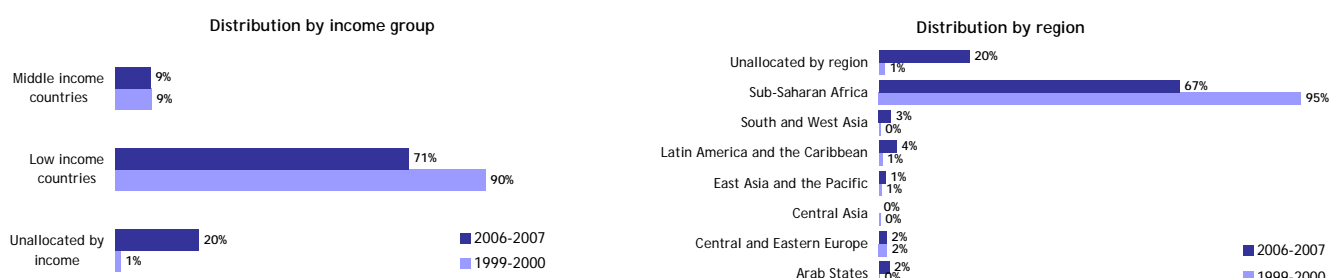

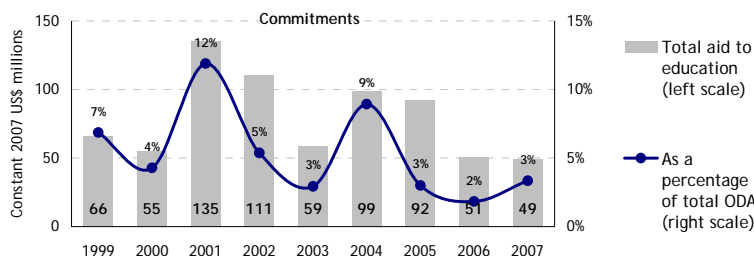

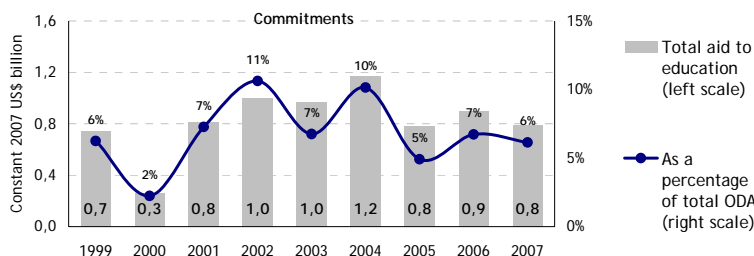

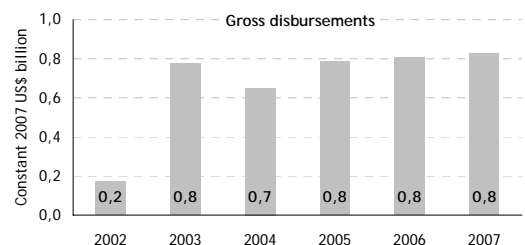

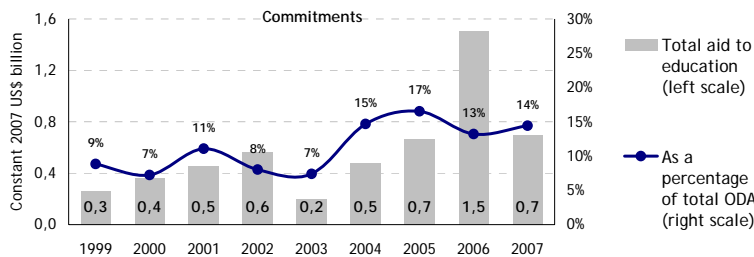

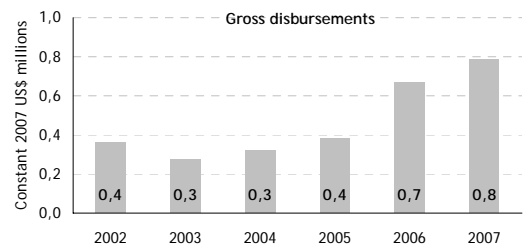

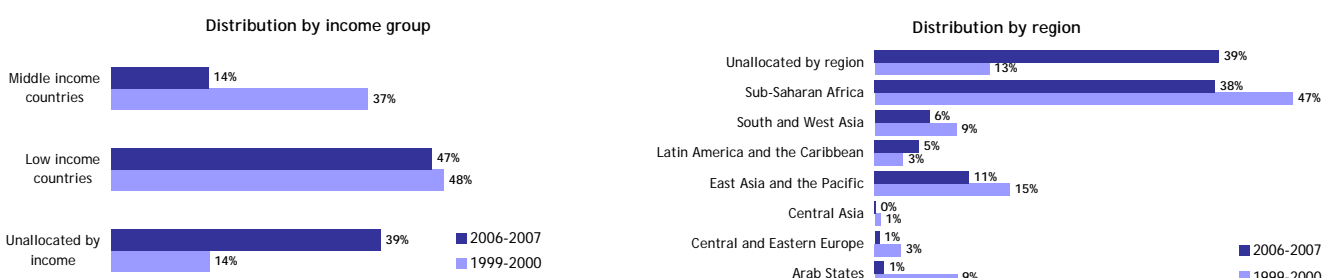

### Total ODA



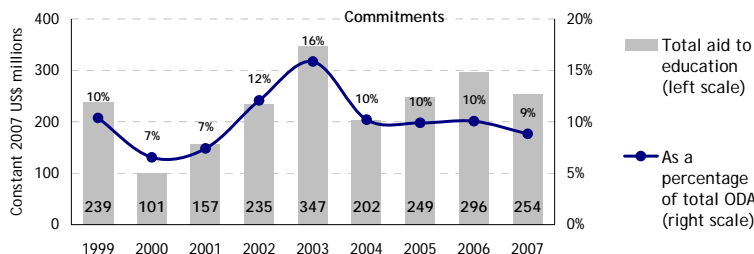

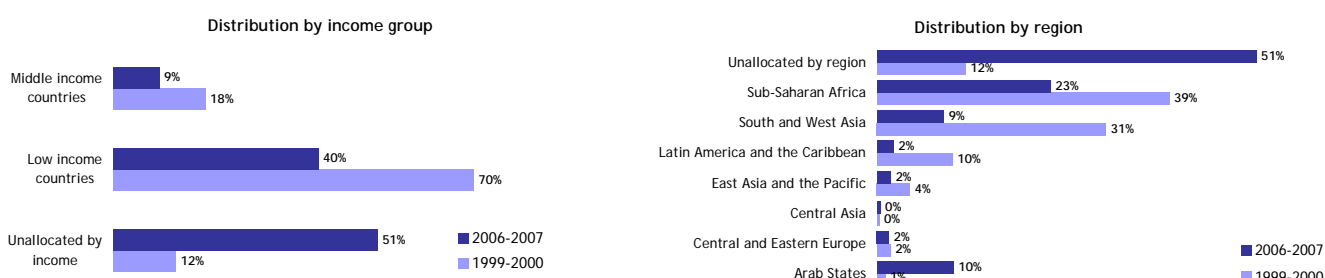

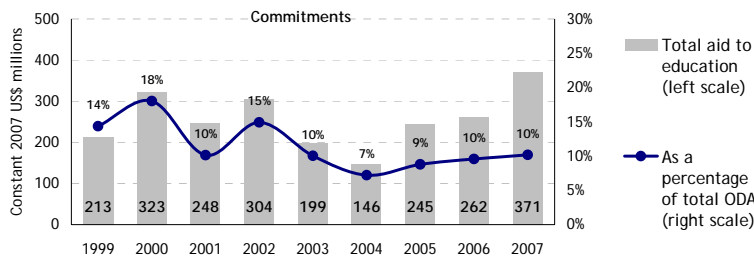

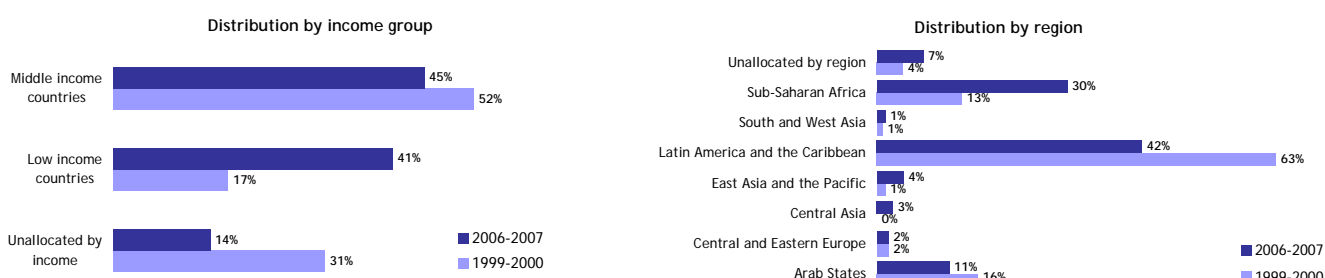

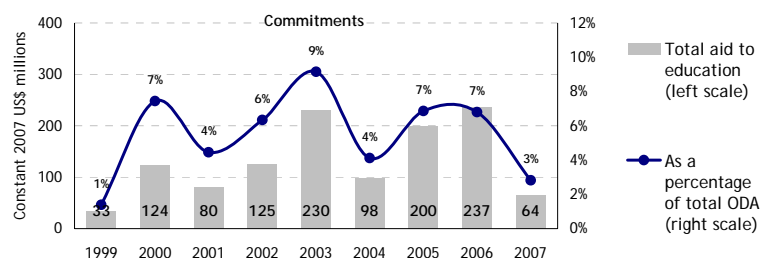

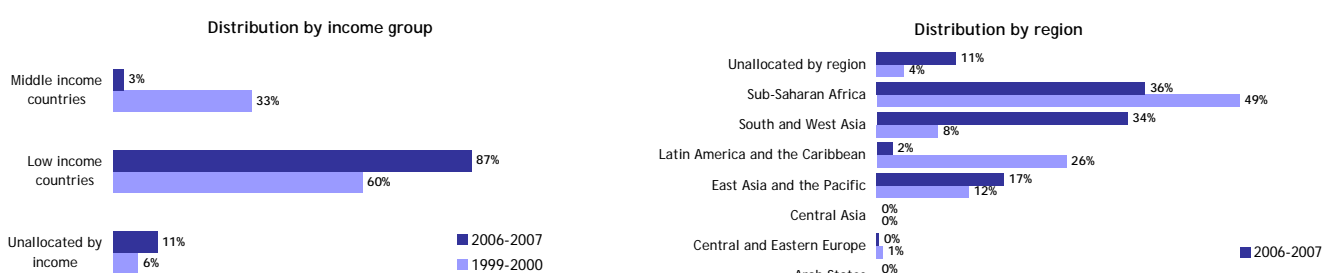

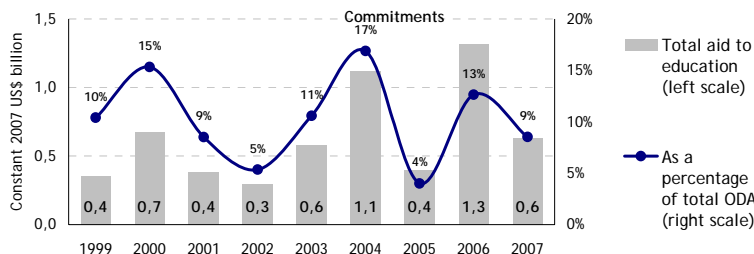

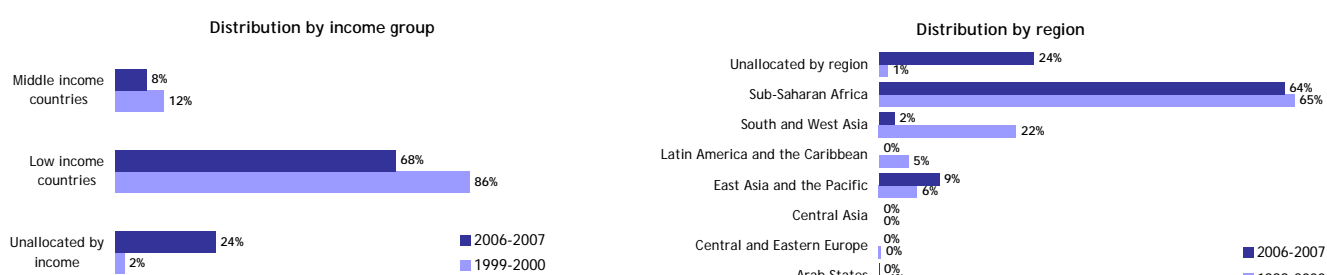

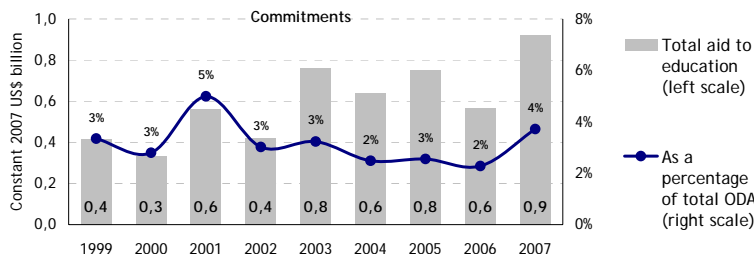

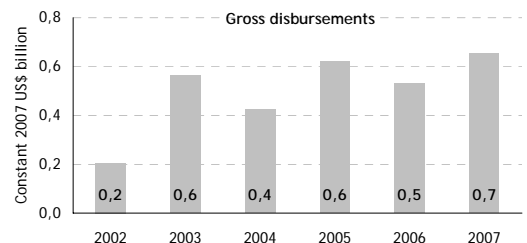

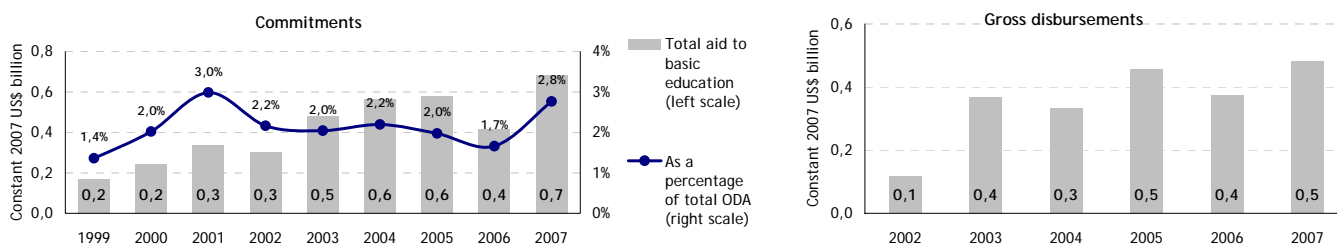

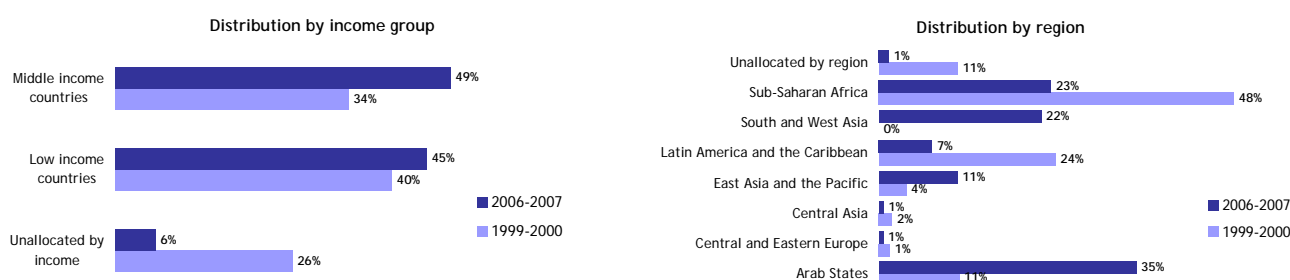

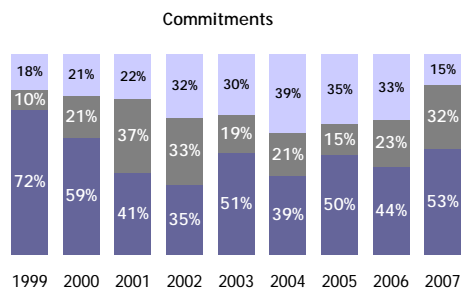

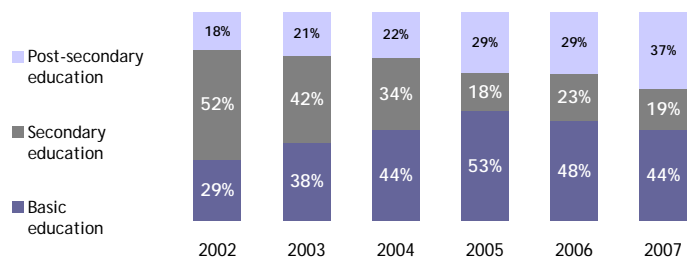

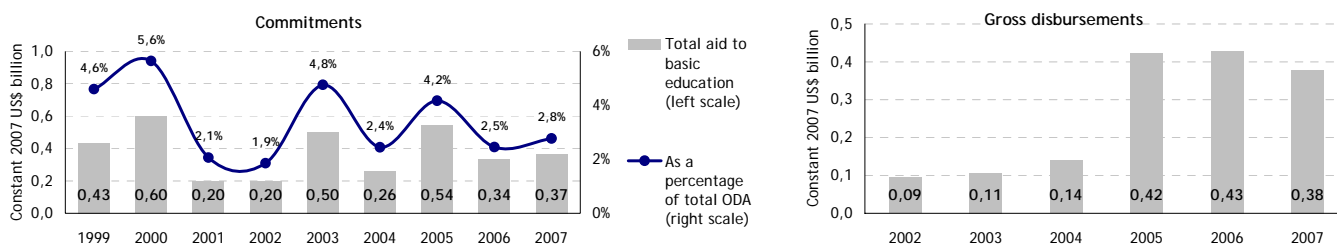

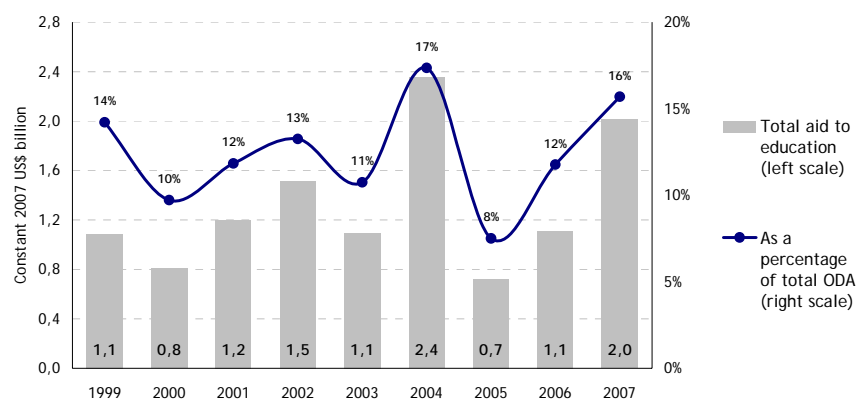

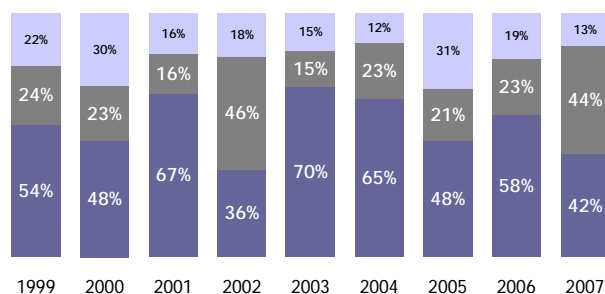

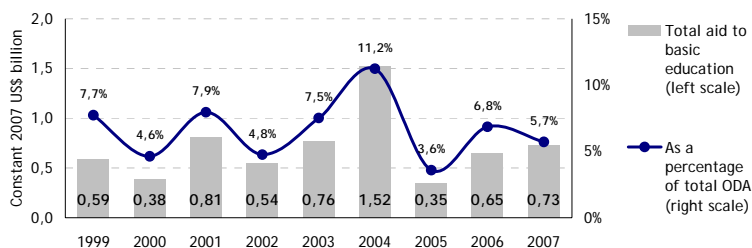
