Examples of implemented projects

The implementing organisation is association Svatobor, which is an organisation with 7 years of experience on the field of community gardening, social enterprise and work with marginalized groups. Organisation is established by Stefan Straka (born in 1979, project manager, psychologist by education - <https://www.facebook.com/stefan.straka.3>) who extended the green-focused activities of the organisation with the strong social aspect. He came with the concept of joining two different marginalized groups which are cooperating and helping each other (marginalized Roma and people with

health and mental disability) and through this interaction gaining new skills which are helping them to succeed in their life in a general society.

Svatobor association realized various social, farmer's and environmentally focused projects up to now.

For example:

1. Establishment of the protected area-eco center Grodzin and development of the eco gardening "Malinka" (realisation: from 11/2006- until now, actual costs :468 000 USD) in partnership with Government office of Slovak republic and Central Office of Labour, Social Affairs and Family. We focus on employment of the young handicapped people, and young poor Romas in the context of gardening, within scope of brooms production from natural materials and also on the services oriented on environmental education)

2. "I want to be an eco farmer" (7/2008 – 6/2010, project costs: 79 950 USD) in co-operation with the French Ministry of Foreign Affairs, with the Fnasat Gens du Voyage and austrian foundation Hermes Osterreich . Low-skilled and long-term unemployed Roma people learned how to cultivate the fruit plants and mushrooms and consequently they established their own gardens in Hlinné region.

3. „Support of the food and energy self sufficiency in poor communities“ (the year 2012- with the Open society foundation and supporting of the companies Zvar and Strapex, project costs: 98 045 USD). This project supported development by the Roma communities in Rudlov and Hanušovce the ecological vegetable production.

4. "The way from vicious circle"(04/2012- 11/2012, project costs: 57 500 USD). Svatobor association was in this project APZ Somotor the partner. The unemployed people were educated and association supported their employment in labour market, for example the locality: energetic and technical using of bio wastes.

5. "Biomass- let it be our fuel" and "The bio-seeds production - preparatory phase "(07/ 2010 -7/2013, project costs: 240 569 USD). In co-operation with UNDP (Program GEF SGP) we secured the equipment in biomass boiler house in Malinka centre and we developed community composting in many villages in Vranov region. We also executed the project preparatory phase intended on bio-seeds production with co-operation with UNDP. Within this preparation we executed also re- cultivation of garden parcels, we successfully managed the testing\experimental phase of plant cultivation and after that we got the permissions from the departments for the bio seed cultivation and reproduction. We also obtained the building license for innovative environmental arrangements aimed at effective water use in the country, we accomplished the building of collecting channel for the rainwater capture. II. Project Proposal

Title of the project Bio-seeds cultivation and reproduction as the key to development of sustainable green local economy in rural regions of Slovakia

Executive summary

The project is placed in the east part of Slovakia (Central Europe), in the Presov region, which, in the long-term perspective, is considered to be among the most marginalized regions in whole Slovakia and

Central European region, showing high level of long-term unemployment, strong concentration of the poverty, no opportunities for marginalized and vulnerable groups and high youth unemployment rate.

Region is typical also by high concentration of marginalized Roma communities and their critical living conditions, showing 65% of elementary school drop-ups and almost 100% unemployment. Among other problems of the region may be listed also strong tension between Roma and non-Roma population (Roma is the biggest ethnic minority in Europe and Slovakia and Roma population, in general, suffers strong marginalization in Slovakia).

Association Svatobor reacted on this situation by establishing and running social enterprise focused on the bio-farming and organic seeds reproduction. Svatobor is currently giving a job to 20 employees (primarily people from marginalized Roma communities and people with disability) and offering number of activities promoting social inclusion of these marginalized and vulnerable groups.

Svatobor was established as an youth initiative and since its start in 2006 has been steadily working on a socio-economic promotion of the region through the bio-farming activities which are organized in a way that creates an opportunities for marginalized and vulnerable from the region and empowers local communities.

Since 2006, when it started from the scratch, Svatobor has succeeded to secure adequate agro-mechanism, land and buildings (e.i. it secured long-term lease of land and buildings); to re-cultivate this land; establish and run community based compost places (these compost places are also the main source of fertiliser in a form of compost Svatobor uses for its farming activities) and not less importantly, Svatobor has been focused on the capacity building, training, re-skilling and employing the members of marginalized Roma communities.

The present project is aiming to up-scale current activities of Svatobor`s social enterprise and to move them one step further, which is a cultivation and reproduction of organic bio-seeds. A precondition for achievement of this aim is a need to solve out an issue of shortage of water needed for irrigation, thus the activities of the project will very much deal also with water management and natural tanks cultivation.

May be expected, that the activities related to bio-seeds cultivation will bring a certain knowledge and innovation to the region and promote a human capital of the region. The previous activities related to bio-seeds reproduction proved its strong potential for the further development of our social enterprise and increased focus on bio-seeds cultivation may bring the social enterprise even further.

Activities of the project are also very much focused on an involvement of marginalized groups (people from marginalized Roma communities and people with disabilities with main focus on the youth), their capacities building and their employment. Project will pay also a strong focus on trainings of other young leaders and replication of Svatobor`s model to our communities.

Expansion of the activities of Svatobor's social enterprise working on the field of eco-gardening and eco-farming, may significantly increase a socio-economic profile of region where Svatobor operates. It will positively impact on the poverty eradication in the region and mainly on an increase of opportunities for marginalized people (people from marginalized Roma communities and people with disabilities with main focus on the youth) from the region.

The project will be implemented for and with young people from marginalized and vulnerable groups by the team of young ones, who are members and sympathizers of the Svatobor association. Except mentioned project manager it represent:

Objective(s) of the project

Goals of the project –

- To reduce poverty and social inequalities chosen communities of Prešov region through the participation in the eco-farming works targeted at bioseeds cultivation and reproduction and land cultivation (primarily water management) and promotion of food self-sufficiency and community eco-gardening
- Promote opportunities for social interaction between the young people from marginalized groups (marginalized Roma and people with disability) themselves and between the young people from marginalized groups and young people from the majority through their involvement to the community-based activities and employment
- Create and sustain job opportunities (full time jobs) for young people from marginalized background (marginalized Roma and people with disability) in the Presov region, which is considered to be one of the most marginalized regions in Slovakia (general registered unemployment is 21%, youth unemployment in the Presov region is almost 43%)
- Based on the experience with running a micro social enterprise to scale-up a sustainable green social enterprise which will target several municipalities and will bring new opportunities for the young people with marginalized background from the region of at least triple size as it is today (currently we are involving two municipalities)
- To bring and concentrate the research and innovation potential in the region of eastern part of Slovakia (Presov region) which suffers a serious brain-drain (educated people have no reason to return back to such a marginalized region as Presov region, Vranov county, is) comparing other Slovak regions

- To promote a green social enterprise business plan, which equally incorporates an eco and social aspects and research and production aspects together, as one of the possible tools for the situation improvement in the environment of rural territories in Slovakia
- To transfer a good experience of practice also to other regions of Slovakia and abroad and to build a capacity of local mayors and young leaders who would be interested to replicate a model also in their communities
- To cultivate and reproduction high-quality bio-seeds for at least 9 different plants (herbs and vegetable) and to meet output indicators specified in the chapter Implementation strategy of this proposal.

Implementation strategy

Places of realization :

- * Areal of ecofarm/community center Malinka and surrounding (municipality Rudlov)
- * Areal Grodzin and surrounding (municipality Ďurďoš)
- * Presov, Bratislava and variety of other places

Time frame : January 2014 – December 2015

The key activities of the project are following:

Activity 1 - Bio-seeds cultivation (= breeding) and reproduction on ecofarm

Malinka (Raspberry) center complex consists of 3 buildings with a yard and is owned by the association. Surrounding land on which will take place farming (= activity 1-2) and also water management activity (= activity 3) are rented from the enterprise Lesy (Forests) SR (until 2057). The building in Grodzin complex is leased (until 2030) from private owners

In the spring of 2014 the gardening cycle will swing in full - from pre-sowing soil preparation, which will be followed by work from sowing / planting, through watering plants, weeding, biological control against diseases and pests (eg via a protective spray from medicinal plants) until seeds collection. During and after the growing season will run final drying, processing, cleaning and packaging of seeds. The cultivation and seed reproduction which are under agreements (on the guaranteed redemption) with company Semo will focus alongside vegetables (tomatoes, dill and squash) also on selected medicinal and aromatic plants (marigold, thyme, mint, camomile, lovage, Balm). Seeds are primarily intended for sale especially on the market in Central and Eastern Europe.

Ten members of staff from Svatobor association will regularly look after cultivation, seed reproduction and composting. These workers come from rural Roma and non-Roma communities. Alongside them, another 20 people from near by villages will help with selected seasonal work (especially weeding and harvest). For their assistance they will earn some money and in addition receive extra benefits such as an opportunity to have land and real gardening tools and seeds. This way part of involved Romas worker

use barter exchange of seeds and other in kind support for their work in gardening activities.

Activity 2 - community-supported organic gardening

The purpose of this activity is to promote food self-sufficiency of poor families who suffer hunger. Grower activity will be similar as activity 1 in form of tillage, soil preparation, sowing and planting, irrigation, weeding, harvest crops, or other gardening works. Of course, these plants will have grown not because of the seeds, but their fruit for consumption.

Cultivation will take place on horticultural land, where we will focus on potatoes, vegetables (especially onions, carrots, zucchini, squash, tomatoes, lettuces, cucumbers, parsley, beetroot), mushrooms (oyster mushroom), and complementarily planting of fruit trees (especially apple, cherries, pears, and walnuts).

We expect to directly involve min. 20 Roma adults with whom we work long-term for several years (since 2006). We have good experience with them and just because of that partnership with these people we managed to carry out rehabilitation of horticultural land in the area Malinka (Raspberry) and around the village Rudlov. Based on our experience, we believe that involved a group of 20 adults will also participate in activities with their children, and seniors. In this way activities will have multigenerational nature. Thanks to these proactive Romas will benefit not only them but also their families and friends. It is assumed that around 100 people from local communities will receive healthy organic food from potatoes, carrots through, onions, tomatoes and various types of fruit (mainly apples and pears).

Activity 3 - Water management measures (section: dam SO -07)

The mentioned unique retention tank will be connected to the already established system of open drains / channels. The open drainage system was created already in the preparatory phase of this project in 2013.

The pond will capture not only part of the water from the stream (during floods), but as well surface and rainwater from ecofarm managed lands. The collected water will be a priority to serve in times of drought on irrigation land (managed in a sustainable manner) intended for cultivation of organic seeds and community-supported organic gardening. In case of fire in gardening, or in the surrounding forests water from tanks will be used to extinguish the fire. Landscaping (planting trees, benches or shoulder) nearby will create space for relaxing for locals and tourists not only in summer but also during the winter months (eg winter frozen pond will serve as an ice rink for children and adults). In the context of the project it is planned to carry out sequentially following activities: excavation - update slopes tank - removal of soil - compaction slopes and bottom of the tank - the imposition of a geotextile sheet and load them - a protective layer of fine aggregate on film - discharge facility (with locks) - and finally saturation tank water.

Professional work using appropriate mechanisms (excavator, vibratory compaction equipment on

terrain, truck, etc..) will be carried out by the professional company that will successfully pass procurement. In accordance with the legislation in public procurement operations will be considered important condition that part of the extra work (eg for manual adjustments to the bottom and slopes tank during loading and removal of soil, or in field and garden landscaping tanks) will be carried out with help of people from the local Roma communities living in poverty.

Activity 4 - Involvement of the marginalized youth and their capacities building

The core of the project is its social aspect and involvement of marginalized youth. Young people facing multiple marginalization (ethnic origin, health disability, geographical marginalization, critical economic situation, social segregation...) will get an opportunity to gain a new skills (social and professional), paid job and consequently they may be expected to get also better social acceptance in the community and society.

The target of the project is an involvement of 60 young unemployed people with marginalized background who will obtain a training and individualized employment services within our project, out of which at least 40 will accomplish a training program and at least 20 will get a full job contract (either in our social enterprise or by other employer who will meet the carries desires of young person better than us)

Among key activities under this category is listed:

- Identification of the project participants – the participants will be identified through the local schools (focus will be primarily on the drop-outs), social workers and informal networks of our employees.
- Training and capacity building of the project participants – after participants` enrolment to the project, an individual development plan will be agreed with each participant. The individual development plan will define the carrier and training desires. According the individual priorities, the adequate training package of professional and support will be provided. Each participant will get a work opportunity within the green activities of our project and package of soft and other skills trainings. Important is interaction between two key target groups (young Roma and you people with disability) which both are living on the edge of society and by the majority are considered to have almost no value. Based on our experience, the interaction between these two groups brings number of benefits primarily on the field of self-esteem and solidarity. The training program will last 18 months.
- Employment for the project participants – main aim of the project is a social inclusion, which, we believe, may be delivered primarily through the participation on the open labour market. Therefore the key focus of our work with marginalized young people will be paid on their possibilities of employment. Specialized job-counsellors will assist our participants to get a paid job on the open labour market. We expect some of the participants to stay with our social enterprise and assist new participants to accomplish the work-integration program, however we expect most of the participant to be placed out of our organisation. The target is 20 participants of the training program to have a full-job contract.

Activity 5 - Transfer of knowledge and dissemination of results

The dissemination of the knowledge, model and its results and information about the project will be

arranged both via internet and in person. International outreach of the project is also planned. All information about the project together with information about the public events and training opportunities organized under the project will be published on the project webpage. On the subject of the “in-person”, among the most relevant events is listed:

- Information days for the mayors – primarily group is mayors from the Presov region, however all who will be interested will be welcome. At least 4 day-long events will take place, audience 20 participants on each, program will be focused on the introducing the social enterprise business model, the activities related cultivation of the country and activities related the social inclusion of the marginalized youngsters.
 - Specialized on-the-spot training and job-shadowing events for mayors – for those who will be interested to replicate our model in their municipalities, we will be offering a tailor-made trainings and consultations about the model replication (possibly modification). During the project phase, at least 10 such events will take place.
 - Information and job-shadowing events for international audience – during the phase of the project 10 people (primarily young entrepreneurs) from Slovakia and abroad will be hosted by the project and learn about the social business concept, our methodology for social inclusion and land cultivation
 - Intense cooperation with media – the strategic partnerships with local and national media will be established and the series of at least 10 press releases and 10 features will be published (this includes also a cooperation with audio-visual media and the series of at least 5 low-cost features will be filmed and published)
 - regional kick-off conference in Presov – audience 40 people from municipalities, business partners, youth, public employment services, relevant ministries and other stakeholders
 - project presentation on at least 3 international conferences – various conferences organized home and abroad (as e.g. Disability Employment Forum, European Employment Forum...) where will be presented the outcomes of the model for the international audience
 - international closing project conference in Bratislava – one-day long event, audience 80 people from public employment services, relevant ministries and other stakeholders from Slovakia and abroad
- Implementation of above listed activities will be supported by intense and on going project management administrated by Svatobor on the professional basis.

The output indicators of the project are following:

- number of young participants from marginalized background involved to our training program (at least 60), number of participants who accomplished the program (at least 40) and number of participants successfully placed on the labour market after accomplishing the program (at least 20)
- number of young leaders from Slovakia and abroad (at least 10) and number of mayors (at least 10) trained at Svatobor in order to replicate our model to their communities
- number of people living below the poverty line , who will be supported by food self-sufficiency - 100 persons
- varieties of vegetable seeds and herbaceous plants produced according the ecological agricultural standards (number of kind of seeds - 9)
- amount of vegetable seeds and herbaceous plants produced according the ecological agricultural

standards (output indicator : amount of seeds - 1000 kg)

- varieties of vegetable and fruit produced in ecological gardening center of supported community (number of kind of vegetable and fruit -10)
- amount of vegetable and fruit produced in ecological gardening center of supported community (amount of vegetable and fruits - 50 000 kg)
- total value of products (bio seeds and ecologically grown vegetable and fruit), created through the project by permanently sustainable way and creating the assets (access to the income and perquisites) for the participants of projects and local Roma communities
- increase of income generated by activities related eco-seeds improvements and its reproduction (social enterprise) and then returned to our organisation – minimum 50 000 USD in the years 2014 and 2015 and minimum 1 000 000 USD during the years 2016-2020 (after the model is fully tested and accommodated). Sales income of bio seeds will be used only for the employment support and for the next development of social entrepreneurship.

- indicators specified at the beginning of the project
- legal documents – i.e. accounting documents
- media coverage - i.e. particular reports in newspapers, magazines, television, or the Internet.
