Monitoring, reporting and evaluation

MONITORING:

- The General Secretariat will be in charge of the monitoring and follow up of projects and activities carried out by continental coordinators and by the working commissions of the MIJARC.
- It will also provide necessary support and information to the continents regarding Trainings, campaigns and other political actions.
- The General Secretariat also will do the operational and logistic support for specific international activities and the participation in important events where MIJARC has to be represented.
- The world team consists of the international President, Secretary, Treasurer and project coordinators will monitor the implementation of the Project at the international Level.
- The two continental coordinators from each continent will monitor their respective continental level project implementation.
- There are two national coordinators in each national movement who will monitor the national level project implementation.
- There are two regional coordinators in each regional movement who will monitor the regional level project implementation.

REPORTING:

- The General Secretariat will be in charge for all type of Reports documentation of projects and activities carried out by its structural coordination.
- It will also provide necessary data and requirements to the donor agency in relation to the project trainings and results.
- The Reports will be maintained at all the levels of Organizational structures to measure the achievements and to frame new strategies.
- Monthly and Half yearly and annual Project reports will be prepared at the Regional and National level and will be forwarded to the Continental Level.
- Half yearly (Six Month) and annual (a Project year) Reports will be prepared at the continental level by accumulating the Regional and National project activities.
- Annual Report will be prepared by accumulating all Continental activities and the same will be sent to the UNESCO with a month after completion of a successful project year. That means 12 month project implementation report will be sent to UNESCO

REPORTING METHODS:

EVALUATION:

- The MIJARC General Secretariat will be in charge for all type of evaluations of the project and activities carried out by its structural coordination.
