


# WORLD FUTURES DAY

## Futures Origami

From the Futures for IGE Project (UNGP-UNESCO, 2023).

### Instructions

1. Back side up, fold 2 diagonals to create a crease in the form of a cross.
2. Back side up, fold each corner to the center of the crease you just did.
3. Turn your paper, face side up.
4. Face side up, fold each corner to the center.
5. Fold and unfold the square horizontally and vertically.
6. Turn over and slide your fingers under the flaps and push the corners to the middle.
7. Choose a theme and ask the question beneath.
8. Start to explore the futures!

In engaging with others, how consciously do you reflect on your own cultural positionality and values?

**Temporal Empathy**  
Can you empathize across time, and consider the perspectives and needs of those in the past, present, and future?

**Advancing Equitability**  
How do your actions today contribute to equitable conditions not only for the present but also for the future?

**Futures Literacy**  
What do you take for granted when you imagine the future?

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
